WHAT:

- In recent years, greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and their effects on global climate change has become a major concern, locally, nationally and globally;
- The State Legislature signed AB 32 into law, which charged the California Air Resources Board (CARB) to develop regulations for mandatory enforceable limits on GHG for major stationary sources with a goal of capping emissions 25% below current levels by 2020;
- The State Attorney General's Office and some environmental groups are asking individual projects to analyze the impacts on global climate change as part of the CEQA process;
- To address this issue AEP has developed an interim analysis procedure addressing climate change impact analysis in CEQA documents;
- A discussion of climate change issues, the regulatory and voluntary markets and brief overview of AEP's recommended interim analysis procedure will be presented
