Forum Overview

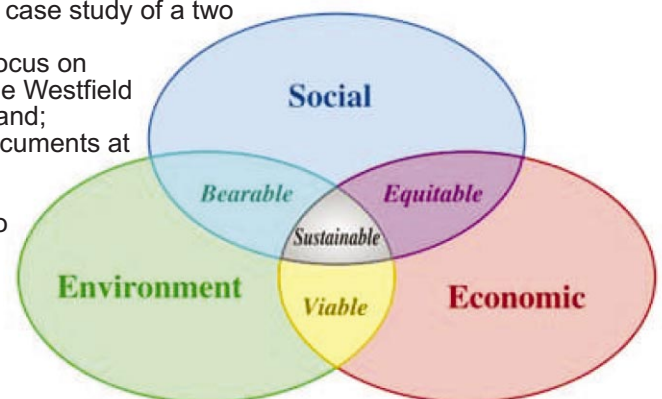
